

Suggested Elevator Guidelines

The current spread of the Delta variant of Covid is being described as much more easily transmissible than the original. Renewed caution is being advised as people increasingly gather, especially in confined spaces such as elevators. While, even during the pandemic's peak, elevators were not cited as one of the major sources for spread, the highly-contagious nature of Delta may place the current situation in a different light. In view of the renewed caution that this now may require, here are some common-sense suggestions for the well-being of all riders:



- **Regardless of vaccination status, wear appropriate face coverings**
- **Self-limit the number of passengers per ride**
- **Load the elevator in a checkerboard pattern, face-forward**
- **Have each passenger announce their desired floor, with the person nearest the button panel selecting for everyone**
- **Avoid conversation in the cab**
- **Continue to keep distance when queuing for the elevator**
